

Instructions for Turnitin

The Nutritional Sciences Graduate Program uses Turnitin.com a software program that checks original work of student papers. It is a plagiarism prevention program. When you set up your individual account with Turnitin for class, make sure you understand and consent to all the terms that the program provides you at that point. You should note that Turnitin – always without your name and any personal information – will retain your paper as part of their database so that students who plagiarize from it can be detected. Because of this program, the vast majority of you who do their own work and cite their sources of information properly will not have to compete with students who commit undetected plagiarism. Anyone who has questions or problem with Turnitin may talk privately about these with their instructor.

1. Go to <http://turnitin.com>
2. Click on “New User”
3. Create a user profile
 - a. Your email address
 - b. Class ID (2812396)
 - c. Class name: Graduate Writing (Recheck Your Work)
 - d. Submit your paper
 - e. Go to inbox and click on “report”
